## How to use it

### Introduction:

Every year, our Hindu and Sikh brothers and sisters celebrate a festival called Diwali. The devotees around the world light diyas (oil lamps) to symbolize the victory of light over darkness and good over evil.

This is a wonderful opportunity for us to join in prayer that all people may come to know the True Light that lights everyone (John 1:9). ### How to Use the Prayer Guide:

For each of the five days, follow these three simple steps:

1. Read the Bible passage/s and the short note about the Bible passage/s.
2. Engage in prayer keeping in mind the first point in the “What to do” section.
3. Continue with your day keeping in mind the second point in the “What to do” section.

You may do this activity during your personal devotional time or with a group, such as a Bible study group or a Sabbath School class.

If you are in a position of leadership, you may also organize a prayer event for your area of influence – church, conference, union, or division.
